### ENTRIES & CLOSING DATE

All entries must be RECEIVED by 9:00 PM, **Monday, June 21, 2010**. No entries may be accepted or withdrawn for any reason after **June 21st**. For entries received by the closing date, the class level of their entry may be changed until 9:00 pm June 28 by email (Val@agiledogs.net). To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date, and accompanied by the correct fees made payable to **AgileDogs**. You must file a separate entry form for each dog entered (i.e., only one dog per form). You may use the same entry form to enter the same dog in different jump heights in the different programs. One jump height per program per entry form.

### CHECK IN AND MEASURING

At check-in you must present your permanent card, temporary card, or USDAA-issued check-in letter. All dogs without a permanent registration card, a completely signed temporary card, or a check-in letter provided by USDAA/print out of dog info page from subscriber account indicating the dog is permanently carded, must be measured!! Change of jump heights will be made only when the dog is required to move into a higher category by the judge's measure-in at this event. The handler can decide to run For Exhibition Only in the lower height, but no awards or qualifying scores may be earned and no change in program is permitted. **NOTE:** The handler of a dog entered in Team/PVP that measures up, must notify the secretary immediately. If the change in jump height makes the dog ineligible for the team, the secretary will make every effort to form complete teams from dogs available. If the dog runs FEO, the team/pair may not qualify; however, the partners may run in the individual classes for placements Top Ten Points and Lifetime Achievement Qs.

There may be Friday night early check in; see the confirmation letter for more details. The site will be open starting at 6:45 on Saturday morning for setup, and check-in shall be between 7:00 am and 7:45 am. All times are tentative and subject to change. Consult your entry confirmation for schedule changes.

All dogs must be registered with USDAA (registration has a "U" prefix) in order to compete in regular classes and tournaments. A "J" prefix number is required for the Junior Handler Program Classes. You may register online at [www.usdaa.com](http://www.usdaa.com) by clicking on General Information, Dog Registration, to obtain a registration number immediately and a measurement card prior to the show. You may also complete and submit the registration form included in this test schedule and submit it with entry for any dog that does not bear a valid USDAA Registration Number.

Note: Jump heights will go low to high, Performance followed by Championship on Saturday, and high to low, Championship followed by Performance on Sunday. Master/PIII Snooker jump height order will be random, and Team/PVP jump height order will vary from class to class.

**\*Re-designed Long Jump** – dogs jumping 8" will jump 2<sup>nd</sup> board only - span of 6", height of 7.5".

### DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE

Shatford Park is located on Route 22; approximate GPS address is 14775 Route 22, New Lebanon NY 12125.

From the South: Take the New York State Thruway North to exit 21A, the "Berkshire Spur", and get off at exit B3 (Austerlitz/New Lebanon). \* Follow signs for Route 22 North. Take Route 22 North for approximately 9 miles to the town of New Lebanon. At the red blinking light take a right to stay on Route 22 North. \*\*About a mile later, take a left just before the old Hess Gas Station (now boarded up) to stay on Route 22 North; go 3/4 mile, past New Lebanon Central School. You'll see the park on the left. Go past the park and take a left after the New Lebanon Town Hall onto Old Post Road. Go .2 miles to the park entrance on the left.

From the West: Take the New York State Thruway to exit 24, Albany. Stay on I-90 (this is a no-toll section) until exit 11E, which is Route 20 East. Turn right onto 20 East, and follow it for approximately 17 miles; go straight through the blinking yellow light in New Lebanon. Follow directions from \*\* above.

From the East: Take the Mass Turnpike to the New York State line, where it becomes the New York Thruway. Take the very first exit in New York, Exit B3 (Austerlitz/New Lebanon), and follow directions from \* above.

From the North: From Hoosick Falls you will take Route 22 South. Go through the town of Berlin. Approximately 3 miles south of the Berlin Jr./Sr. High School is Giles Road on the left. Continue with directions from \*\* above.

## NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Competitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA rules and regulations, which are hereby incorporated by reference, including, but not limited to, the following rules and conditions for submission and acceptance of entry:

- ✓ The test is open to all dogs at least 18 months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's ability to perform safely, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression.
- ✓ The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the committee views that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee so doing must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy to the USDAA office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.
- ✓ Safety shall always be of foremost consideration at all times. Handlers through entry at this event accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs and/or children.
- ✓ No leads, collars, food, toys, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.
- ✓ Agility obstacles shall meet the requirements of USDAA Rules and Regulations.
- ✓ No entries may be accepted or withdrawn for any reason after the closing date.
- ✓ There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. Any dog or handler that pulls from the competition after the closing date due to injury or illness will receive, if a doctor's note is provided, a refund of up to 50% of entry fees, at the club's discretion.
- ✓ All Competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of United States Dog Agility Association, Inc.
- ✓ Portions of this event may be taped for television. Through entry at this event, ALL COMPETITORS AND HANDLERS HEREBY GRANT to USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media now known or hereafter to become known. All competitors and handlers hereby release USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.
- ✓ All fees are payable in US Dollars and no entry fee will be refunded if the Test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- ✓ Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check where notifications are received after event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registrations numbers(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is cancelled without recourse by the owner/handler.
- ✓ Competitors must pick up after their dog(s). Anyone not cleaning up after his or her dog(s) at the trial site or hotel will be asked to leave. No entry fees will be refunded to any competitor asked to leave due to failure to clean up after their dog(s).
- ✓ Fault limits may be applied in all classes for which faults are assessed. Limits shall be announced during the judge's briefings.
- ✓ Competitors (handler or their dog) may not enter any class held for title under a judge who resides in the same household or with whom they have trained in the past ten (10) days.

## CLASS DESCRIPTIONS & ELIGIBILITY

The following titling classes are being offered at the Starters, PI, Advanced, PII, Masters, and PIII levels at this event:

### Standard, Gamblers, Jumpers, Pairs Relay, and Snooker

A complete description of these classes and the requirements for eligibility for entry may be found in Chapters 3-7 of Official USDAA Rules & Regulations, which are incorporated in this test schedule by reference. A summary of eligibility requirements for all titling classes is presented in Appendix E of the Rules & Regulations. Competitors may enter both Championship and Performance classes for which they may be eligible; however, no dog may be entered in the same class regardless of level at this event.

Pairs is now required for titling at all levels of Performance and follows the same rules as for the Championship Program. In either program, should only one dog be entered in a level/program, un-entered dog or dogs from other programs/levels may NOT be recruited to form a qualifying pair.

**Brace Game!** This class is open to all Championship and Performance levels. This will be a modified starters-style standard course judged under Starters rules. The following obstacles may be used: jumps (winged and non-winged, no spreads), tunnels, weave poles, table, and A-frame (set at 5'0" for all dogs). A team will consist of one handler and two dogs running the course simultaneously. The jump height will be set at the lowest height of the two dogs based on each dog's standard class jump height; five (5) jump heights will be offered: 8", 12", 16", 22" and 26". Scoring will be time plus faults. Mini will be 8", 12", 16" (Champion), and Open will be 16" (Perf.), 22" and 26". 1st through 6th place rosettes will be awarded in mini and open divisions. ***This class is non-qualifying.***



## JUNIOR HANDLER PROGRAM

The USDAA Junior Handler Program is for children eighteen years of age and younger. Dogs and Junior Handlers may compete in the Junior Handler Program without regard to their accomplishments in other agility classes. The class will be scored under the provisions of the Chapter 8 USDAA rules and regulations. Each dog/handler team **MUST** have a separate "J" registration number to compete in these classes.

The Beginners class shall be for dogs that have not earned the JH Beginners Agility<sup>SM</sup> certificate. Completion of one round in this class within the stipulated time without fault shall earn the USDAA's JH Beginners Agility<sup>SM</sup> certificate of accomplishment. The handler may choose to run the Beginners class on-leash or off-leash. This choice must be made at the time of entry and may not be changed after the closing date. The maximum height for dogs run on leash is 16". In this round, the obstacle course shall be comprised of ten obstacles set in a simple horseshoe or "S" shape design. The A-Frame shall be set at 4'6". The table will be set at 12". The standard course time is 60 seconds. Each Junior Handler in the Beginners class will have to complete a 10 question true/false quiz. The judge or a club member will review the quizzes and any missed questions prior to the class with the Junior Handlers.

The Elementary class shall be open to dogs that have earned the JH Beginners Agility<sup>SM</sup> certificate but have not earned the JH Elementary Agility<sup>SM</sup> certificate. Completion of two rounds in this class within the stipulated time without fault shall earn the JH Elementary Agility<sup>SM</sup> certificate of accomplishment. In this round, the obstacle course shall be comprised of ten obstacles set in a simple horseshoe or "M" shape design. The A-Frame shall be set at 5'0". The table will be set at 12". The standard course time is 60 seconds.

The Intermediate class shall be open to dogs that have earned the JH Elementary Agility<sup>SM</sup> certificate but have not earned the JH Intermediate Agility<sup>SM</sup> certificate. Completion of three rounds in this class within the stipulated time without fault shall earn the JH Intermediate Agility<sup>SM</sup> certificate of accomplishment. In this round, the obstacle course shall be comprised of simple design, being slightly more challenging than a figure of "8", and shall include twelve (12) to fourteen (14) obstacles. The A-Frame shall be set at 5'6". The table will be set at 12" for dogs jumping 8" and 12" and will be at 16" for dogs jumping 16" or 22". The standard course time is 75 seconds.



The Senior class shall be open to dogs that have earned the JH Intermediate Agility<sup>SM</sup> certificate. Completion of three rounds in this class within the stipulated time without fault shall earn the JH Senior Agility<sup>SM</sup> certificate of accomplishment. In this round, the obstacle course shall be of simple design, being slightly more challenging than a figure of “8”, and shall include thirteen (13) to fifteen (15) obstacles. The A-Frame shall be set at 5’6” for the 8” and 12” jump heights and at 5’10” for the 16” and 22” jump heights. The table will be set at 12” for dogs jumping 8” and 12” and will be at 16” for dogs jumping 16” or 22”. The standard course time shall be computed at the rate of two yards per second not to exceed 75 seconds.

**TOURNAMENT CLASSES** – A copy of the tournament regulations for each tournament may be viewed on the USDAA website at [www.usdaa.com](http://www.usdaa.com).



The following Tournament classes are being offered at this event: NOTE: all competitors are eligible for entry to any of these tournament classes.

**Dog Agility Masters® Team and Performance Versatility Pairs<sup>SM</sup>** – A team may be comprised of dogs from any two Championship height classes. A pair may be comprised of dogs from any two Performance height classes. One qualifying score as described in the complete rules is required for entry in the World Championships.

**Grand Prix of Dog Agility® and Performance Grand Prix<sup>SM</sup>** – A qualifying score is zero faults. One Q is required for entry in a Regional Championships. Two qualifying scores are required for entry in the quarterfinals at the World Championships.

## AWARDS

**Titling Classes** – Ribbons will be awarded to dog/handler teams placing 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place in all classes in their respective jump heights and in mini and open divisions for pairs relay. Maroon qualifying rosettes will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score in any non-tournament classes. Special rosettes will be awarded to those finishing a title.

**Fun Class – Brace Game:** Rosettes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place in mini and open divisions.

**Junior Handler Classes** - Gold medallions will be awarded for performances yielding five or fewer faults, silver medallions for between five and fifteen faults, and bronze medallions for more than fifteen faults. Q rosettes will be awarded for Clear Rounds.

**Dog Agility Masters® Team and Performance Versatility Pairs<sup>SM</sup>** – Prizes and awards will be made based upon overall team scores after five rounds. USDAA will provide “Gold”, “Silver” & “Bronze” medallions at local qualifying events for the three top scoring teams/pairs. Qualifying label pins will be awarded to each member of each qualifying team or pair. Rosettes for 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> place overall will be awarded for Championship and Performance divisions; ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> place will be awarded for each of the four classes (Standard, Jumpers, Gamblers, and Jumpers) for each jump height.

**Grand Prix of Dog Agility® and Performance Grand Prix<sup>SM</sup>** - The first place qualifying handler/dog team in each height class shall earn a “bye” voucher, permitting them to enter or directly advance to the final round of a regional championship. A double maroon and white ribbon shall be awarded to all qualifiers in the Grand Prix, with a double maroon and pink ribbon awarded to all qualifiers in the Performance Grand Prix. Ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> place will be awarded for each jump height.
