Directions from the East: Take the Mass Pike to the end, go through the toll booths and continue on. Exit at B-3 in Canaan, NY. At the end of the ramp go right, 22 North. In New Lebanon, Routes 20 and 22 run together for a short while; turn right at the blinking red light to stay on 20/22 North. Make sure you stay on route 22 by bearing left just before the abandoned gas station on your left. Continue to the traffic light in Stephentown where Routes 22 and 43 intersect. Go straight to continue on 22 North. Follow Directions from the 22/43 intersection below.

Directions from the West: Take I-90 East to Exit 11E - Route 20 East. Continue on Route 20 East until it joins Route 22 North. Follow Directions from the 22/43 intersection below.

Directions from the North: From Hoosick Falls you will take Route 22 South. Go through the town of Berlin. Approximately 3 miles south of the Berlin Jr/Sr High School on your left is Giles Road or County Route 33. Follow directions in last paragraph below.

Directions from the 22/43 Intersection: Heading North on Route 22, you'll go up a hill where 22 becomes 2 lanes. It goes back down to one lane after you get to the top of the hill and you will pass a mobile home park on your right. Just after that is a gray house with a small satellite dish. The road on the right just after that house is Giles Road or County Route 33.

Take that road, it is short and takes a sharp right at a horse farm on your right. You will go over a little bridge, you'll see farm buildings on both sides of the road and straight ahead on the right you'll see a yellow sign for Sugar Bush Farm. Follow the driveway straight out to the agility fields.

Entries & Acceptance

Express & Overnight Entries

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age, regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA® Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at www.usdaa.com.

No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

General Entry Conditions

Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children or guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.

Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

Class Descriptions

Team & Versatility Pairs Measure-up Policy

The handler of a dog entered in Team or Versatility Pairs must notify the secretary immediately should their dog be required to jump a higher height by virtue of the judge's measurement. The dog must jump the higher jump height in order to be eligible to earn a qualifying score in the tournament. If entered in Team, the dog may not be moved to Versatility Pairs. If the handler chooses *not* to have their dog jump the higher height, their entry is effectively withdrawn. The competitor may or may not run for exhibition only (earning no qualifications) solely at the discretion of the event secretary; there shall be no refund of fees paid.

If the change in height makes the dog ineligible for their team (three jump heights), the secretary will make every effort to form complete teams from dogs available. A move-up in height for dogs in Versatility Pairs does not affect their team composition, but may result in a change in their position in the running order because of the height composition of the Pair.

Titling Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more titling classes shall be held at this Event from those described in Chapters 3 - 8 of USDAA Official Rules & Regulations, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm, and any amendments there to, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg.cfm, each of which are hereby incorporated by reference.

Tournament Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more tournament classes are being held at this event, the rules and description of which may be downloaded on the Internet at www.usdaa.com/gen_formDoc.cfm, and are hereby incorporated by reference. A written copy may be obtained from the Event secretary.

Brace Game

This class is open to all Championship and Performance levels. This will be a modified starters-style standard course judged under Starters rules. The following obstacles may be used: jumps (winged and non-winged, no spreads), tunnels, weave poles, table, and A-frame (set at 5'0" for all dogs). A team will consist of one handler and two dogs running the course simultaneously. The jump height will be set at the lowest height of the two dogs based on each dog's standard class jump height; five (5) jump heights will be offered: 8", 12", 16", 22" and 26". Scoring will be time plus faults. This class is non-qualifying.

Prizes & Awards

Titling Class & Tournament Awards

Titling Classes – Ribbons will be awarded to dog/handler teams placing 1st through 4th in all classes in their respective jump height and in mini and open divisions for pairs relay. Maroon qualifying rosettes will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score in any non-tournament class. Special rosettes will be awarded to those finishing a title.

Steeplechase and Performance Speed JumpingSM – Those qualifying in Round 1 will receive a special qualifying ribbon. Rosettes for 1st through 4th place in Round 2 will be awarded for each jump height in addition to prize money distributed in accordance with the chart found in the tournament rules at www.usdaa.com.

Dog Agility Masters® Team and Performance Versatility PairsSM – Prizes and awards will be made based upon overall scores after five rounds. USDAA will provide "Gold", "Silver" & "Bronze" medallions for the three top scoring teams/pairs. Qualifying label pins will be awarded to each member of each qualifying team or pair. Rosettes for 1st – 4th place overall will be awarded for Championship and Performance divisions; ribbons for 1st – 4th place will be awarded for each of the four classes (Standard, Jumpers, Gamblers, and Jumpers) for each jump height.

Other Class - Brace Game

First through sixth place ribbons will be awarded overall.

On Sunday, test classes will be run high to low, Championship followed by Performance. Masters/PIII Snooker jump height order will be random.

Check-in & Measuring

Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs not jumping 26" in the Championship Program or 22" in the Performance Program must be measured unless they have a permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration card or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). When not enrolling electronically, please send a copy of one the following items to facilitate the check-in process:

- photocopy of permanent dog registration card,
- printout of the dog-information page from your USDAA® competitor web account, or
- copy of your check-in letter from USDAA indicating your temporary card has been accepted by the USDAA office and your permanent registration card is in process.

A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In - May Run FEO

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor may opt to run the dog in the lower jump height class "For Exhibition Only", and no awards or qualifying scores may be earned. The competitor may not change their entry from one program to another (e.g., from Championship to Performance).

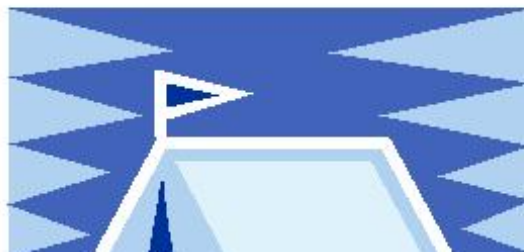
